COMMUNITY AREA

Clearing is located on the far west side of Chicago and covers the neighborhoods of Clearing East, Clearing West, and Chrysler Village. The southern portion of Chicago Midway Airport is located in Clearing. Clearing offers quiet tree-lined streets and single-family homes with picket fences and green yards. Providing ample indoor (and outdoor) living space in an urban setting, the Clearing neighborhood offers an ideal locale to start and raise a family.

NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS

Elementary Schools:

Clearing is served by three elementary schools. The eastern-most area is served by Azula which has a Level 1 rating. The central area of Clearing is served by Hale which has a Level 1+ rating. The western end of Clearing is served by Dore which has a rating of 1.

High Schools:

Most of this community area is served by Kennedy High School which is rated 2+ while some areas in the eastern-most portion of the community are served by Hubbard which is rated Level 1.

CPS Rating Scale is 1+ and 1, 2+ and 2, 3+ and 3. 1+ being the highest performance and 3 being the lowest.
