COMMUNITY AREA

Edison Park is located on the far Northwest Side of Chicago/ It is a quaint and quiet residential community, with most housing being single family homes and smaller, low-profile apartment buildings. Edison Park offers a variety of parks and forest preserves, a good deal of dining and shopping options, and convenient proximity to O'Hare International Airport and the Norhtwest Suburbs.

NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS

Elementary Schools:

Edison Park is served by Ebinger Elementary School which has a Level 1+ rating.

High Schools:

Edison Park is served by Taft High School which has a Level 1 rating.

CPS Rating Scale is 1+ and 1, 2+ and 2, 3+ and 3. 1+ being the highest performance and 3 being the lowest.

COMMUNITY SAFETY

Community area violent crime ranking is 77th of 77 Community Areas, making Edison Park the community area with the lowest violent crime rate in the City of Chicago (1 = highest, 77 = lowest)

TRANSPORTATION

There are 6 bus lines in Edison Park, some of which connect to the CTA Blue Line, as well as a Metra station that reaches downtown and the suburbs.
