



ARCHER HEIGHTS

COMMUNITY AREA

The Archer Heights community area is located on the Southwest Side of Chicago and is primarily a middle-class neighborhood. The area is named after Archer Avenue, which runs from south of Chicago's downtown area through the southwest side of Chicago and beyond into the southwest suburbs. Archer Heights has ample grocery and other retail shopping options, much of which can be found on Pulaski Road, as well as restaurants and a public library. The neighborhood is quiet, having a low profile and relatively low population density.
