



HERMOSA

COMMUNITY AREA

The Hermosa community area is located on the Northwest Side of Chicago, just west of Logan Square. It offers mid-sized apartment buildings and modest single family homes. The community is one of few in Chicago that still has a sizable manufacturing base. Many of the people who reside in Hermosa have done so because of its convenient location to work, its relative proximity to downtown, and because of its healthy public transportation options.

NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS

Elementary Schools:

The southern part of this community area is served by Nixon Elementary, rated Level 2. The central area is served by Barry, rated Level 1, and the northern area is served by Scammon which has a Level 1+ rating.

High Schools:

Served by Level 2 rated Schurz High School on the northern end, Kelvyn Park, Level 2, in the center, and Level 2 North Grand to the south..

CPS Ratings: 1+ and 1, 2+ and 2, 3+ and 3. 1+ being the highest performance and 3 is the lowest
