COMMUNITY AREA

The Beverly community area is located on the South Side of Chicago, on the southwestern edge of the city. The area is one of the top five largest historic districts in any major city in the U.S. It has quick access to downtown, airports, shopping, and attractions, yet maintains itself as a peaceful and quiet wooded community characterized by single family homes and low-profile apartment buildings.

Elementary Schools:
