



WEST TOWN

COMMUNITY AREA

The West Town community area is located on the near north side of Chicago. It covers the neighborhoods of:

- East Village
- Noble Square
- Ukrainian Village
- Wicker Park
- River West
- Bucktown

The trendy area is home to some of Chicago's best restaurants and shopping, and yet has quiet residential streets, as well.

NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS

Elementary Schools:

To the Southeast, Level 1+ rated Ogden; more centrally around Wicker Park, and Ukrainian Village Level 2 rated De Diego; further north around Palmer Square, Level 1+ rated Chase, and on the northern end around Bucktown, Level 1+ rated Burr.

High Schools:

Areas around river West and Bucktown are served by Wells High School, rated Level 2+. The rest of the community area is served by Clemente, rated Level 2.

CPS Rating Scale is 1+ and 1, 2+ and 2, 3+ and 3. 1+ being the highest performance and 3 being the lowest.

COMMUNITY SAFETY

Community area violent crime ranking is 15th of 77 Community Areas (1 = highest, 77 = lowest)

TRANSPORTATION

There are 8 bus lines, the Blue Line Train, easy bus connections to the Pink and Green lines, as well as a Metra line.
