



BRIDGEPORT

COMMUNITY AREA

The Bridgeport community area is located on the near South Side of Chicago. It is bounded, generally, on the north by the South Branch of the Chicago River, on the west by Bubbly Creek (the river's South Fork), on the south by Pershing Road, and on the east by the Union Pacific railroad tracks.

Bridgeport ranks today as one of the most racially diverse areas in Chicago.

NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS

Elementary Schools:

Bridgeport is served by two 1+ rated elementary schools, Healy and McLelland.

High Schools:

This community area is served by Tilden High school rated at Level 2.
