COMMUNITY AREA

The Hyde Park community area is located on the Southeast Side of Chicago. The neighborhood is the home of the University of Chicago and the Museum of Science and Industry. The Hyde Park shoreline along Lake Michigan is great for outdoor activities, and the area has a diverse mix of restaurants, shopping, historic landmarks and several seasonal events, bike tours and neighborhood street festivals.

NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS

Elementary Schools:

This community area is served by Shoesmith Elementary to the north with a Level 1+ rating while the southern half is served by Level 2+ rated Ray Elementary.

High Schools:

Hyde Park is served by Level 1+ rated Kenwood High School.

CPS Ratings: 1+ and 1, 2+ and 2, 3+ and 3. 1+ being the highest performance and 3 is the lowest
