COMMUNITY AREA

The Edgewater community area is located on the Northeast Side of Chicago and covers the neighborhoods of:

- Edgewater Beach
- Andersonville
- Edgewater Glen
- and some other small, cozy enclaves

Edgewater sits along the shore of Lake Michigan, affording breathtaking landscapes and beachfront activities. It has long been one of Chicago's most popular and diverse communities.

NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS

Elementary Schools:

Eastern Edgewater is served by Siwft, a Level 2+ school. The central area of the community is served by Pierce with a Level 1 rating, while the western side is served by Hayt, also with a Level 1 Rating.

High Schools:

Edgewater is served by Senn High School which has a Level 1 rating.

CPS Rating Scale is 1+ and 1, 2+ and 2, 3+ and 3. 1+ being the highest performance and 3 being the lowest.

COMMUNITY SAFETY

Community area violent crime ranking is 39th of 77 Community Areas (1 = highest, 77 = lowest)

TRANSPORTATION

Edgewater offers 10 buses, including express buses to downtown, as well as the CTA Red Line.
