



# ROGERS PARK

## COMMUNITY AREA

The Rogers Park community area is located on the far northeast side of Chicago. A diverse community, it includes the Glenwood Arts District and Jarvis Square. It is a charming area along Lake Michigan, with both quiet residential areas and strips of restaurants and shopping around Loyola University. There are many lakefront beaches and parks to visit and easy transportation to both downtown and the northern suburbs. Amenities are steadily being added to this community, including a variety of grocery options.

## NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS

### Elementary Schools:

Southern Rogers Park is served by Kilmer, rated Level 1. The central area is served by Field with a Level 2 rating, and the northern side is served by Gale, also with a Level 2 Rating.

### High Schools:

Rogers Park is served by Senn High School in the north with a Level 1 rating. The rest of the community is served by Level 2+ rates Sullivan.

CPS Rating Scale is 1+ and 1, 2+ and 2, 3+ and 3. 1+ being the highest performance and 3 being the lowest.
