



DUNNING

COMMUNITY AREA

Dunning is on the Northwest Side of Chicago, situated between the Portage Park and Irving Park neighborhoods to the east and suburban towns to the west. Dunning is quiet and low-profile, with housing stock consisting of single family homes and small apartment buildings. Dunning offers a lot of green space, including parks and forest preserves. It is also home to Wilbur Wright Chicago City College and is within easy reach of a variety retail shopping options.

NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS

Elementary Schools:

Dunning is served by 3 elementary schools. Canty and Bridge are both Level 1+ rated while Smyser, on the eastern side of the community is rated Level 1.

High Schools:

Dunning is served by two high schools. To the east is Schurz with a Level 2 rating and to the west is Steinmetz, rated Level 2+.

CPS Rating Scale is 1+ and 1, 2+ and 2, 3+ and 3. 1+ being the highest performance and 3 being the lowest.

Community area violent crime ranking is 60th of 77 Community Areas (1 = highest, 77 = lowest)

TRANSPORTATION
