



# IRVING PARK

## COMMUNITY AREA

The Irving Park community area is located on the Northwest Side of Chicago. It includes the neighborhoods of, Kilbourn Park, Old Irving Park, Independence Park, and Mayfair. While there are some warehouses and industrial stretches, mostly along Elston Avenue, the bulk of the area is middle-class residential homes. The streets are lined with trees, and once you turn off the main roads, car traffic is minimal. There is ample shopping opportunities here as well.

### Elementary Schools:

The easternmost portion of the community area is served by Level 1 rated Bateman, the central area by Level 1 rated Henry, and the western portion by Level 1+ rated Belding.

### High Schools:

Irving Park is served by Roosevelt to the southeast with a Level 2 Rating while the rest of the area is served by Schurz, also Level 2.

CPS Ratings: 1+ and 1, 2+ and 2, 3+ and 3. 1+ being the highest performance and 3 is the lowest
