COMMUNITY AREA

The West Elsdon community area is located on the Southwest Side of Chicago and is considered a “twin neighborhood” of West Lawn community area. The area is known for its well-maintained bungalows, spruce lawns, and growing diversity. A number of schools and public parks add to West Elsdon's cultural aspects, and a sizable commercial corridor along Pulaski Road presents residents with lots of shopping and dining selections.

Elementary Schools:

West Elsdon is served by Peck Elementary and Pasteur Elementary, both have a Level 1 rating.. For grades 5 through 8, the school for this community is Richardson which, at the time this page was printed, was not yet rated.

High Schools:

This community area is served by Currie high School which has a Level 2+ rating.
