The Near North Side community area is located north and east of the Chicago River covers the neighborhoods of Gold Coast, Old Town, Goose Island, River North, and Streeterville, which is home to the “Magnificent Mile” shopping district on Michigan Ave. It is the oldest community area of Chicago, dating back to the 1780s. Elementary Schools:

The Near North Side has some high performing schools. The area is dense and the boundaries are irregular so be sure to use the CPS website to check specific addresses. Elementary Schools include Ogden which is rated Level 1+, Jenner at Level 2, and Manierre which has a Level 1 rating.

High schools include Lincoln Park High School, rated Level 1+ and Wells, rated Level 2+

CPS Ratings: 1+ and 1, 2+ and 2, 3+ and 3. 1+ being the highest performance and 3 is the lowest
